## The Complete Package

In my 10 years of being humanitarian chair of SCI Southeast Michigan Bowhunters Chapter I have been blessed with chapter support to have taken many physically challenged youngsters and Veterans on hunts and fishing trips. I have witnessed the looks of amazement and joy on the faces of many as they, for one day, were able to leave the problems they have to live with every day of their lives and give them memories to live with forever.



I have been to many places and met many good people who care about the less fortunate. This year I met a group that has taken this adventure to a new height, The Legends Ranch. It starts with ranch manager, Robert Sergi, one of the most caring and devoted people I know. Robert has put together a group of great people that show how much they care and are willing to make your stay with them one you will truly never forget.

I was invited up to Legends Ranch during their youth challenge hunt where disabled, handicapped and terminally ill children are provided hunt opportunities to score a big whitetail buck, and to give each child the feeling that they truly are special. I delivered an Action Tract Wheel Chair for one of the youngsters to use during the hunt as I, President of Camp Liberty, have four of these chairs that were donated to us, to ensure anyone who wants to be in the great outdoors can indeed do so, with the help of these amazing chairs.

I was invited to stay for the youth hunt but I had other commitments. Robert asked if I would do them the honor of coming to the ceremony they hold on the last day and be one of their speakers. I told him I would be honored to be there - I didn't know what to expect but it was truly a beautiful sight to witness, they had all four youngsters seated in the middle of the lawn (after a great breakfast) and had all everyone surround them as one of the guides talked about the hunts, then sang a song that he had written. Each youngster was given a trophy with their name on it, a backpack full of goodies, and shirts with their names on it.

Their deer were brought out from the coolers, so that they could pose them with all the youngsters. Randy Flanery, a taxidermist, was there from Westwind Taxidermy in Scottsville, MI., and agreed to mount their deer in any pose they wanted.

I was so moved by what I had just witnessed that I called Jenny Olsen from Michigan Out of Doors TV and asked her if she could possibly tape a show the following week at the purple heart veterans hunt that our chapter had co-sponsored, as this was really special. Jenny said that she could come up but couldn't stay for the ceremony as she had other commitments. That Wednesday I arrived at Legends with one of my board members from Camp Liberty, Ron Rowley. Ron wanted to come because one of the veterans chosen for the hunt was Ron's nephew, Jeff Smith.

Jenny Olsen arrived that afternoon and met everyone, then we all had a great dinner and went with different Veterans, along with their guides to the blinds. The blinds were all elevated, and had room for at least four people with room to spare. I have never seen so many 200 class deer in my life due to the great breeding program that Robert Sergi (who is also a biologist) came up with.

As the Veterans and guides arrived back at the camp at the end of the day the whole Legends Ranch group were waiting to greet them and applaud the successful hunters, and took many pictures as the story of each hunt was told. We all got up early each morning to go out hunting after a great breakfast. Those veterans that had already gotten their deer could either go out and observe the deer, sit with a fellow veteran in their



blind, or just sleep in if they wanted. During the day you could either go fishing on one of the two pontoon boats with all fishing gear provided, or just hang out at the ranch. Robert and his crew were there to make sure everyone had everything they needed to make them have a great time. We all went down to the breeding pens where we fed young fawns with whole peanuts, which they loved to eat. The breeding facilities were spotless, as everything on the ranch was very well kept. By Friday morning everyone had shot a beautiful buck, and all were ready for the ceremony, which was started with all the Purple Heart Veterans seated in the center of the lawn.

One of the guides started with the Pledge of Allegiance, then proceeded to sing a song about the sacrifices that these veterans had made for our great country. Robert Sergi spoke about what an honor it was to host this special hunt, and the guides presented each veteran that they guided with dog tags made by the Legends Ranch. George Coward was so moved by this that he gave his guide one of his own dog tags - it truly was a special moment. Robert gave out challenge coins that they had made up, which were truly beautiful. The deer were brought out so that everyone could see what great bucks they were, and to take many group pictures, so we can always remember what a great time we all had. All the deer heads will be mounted by Randy Flanery of Westwind Taxidermy in Scottsville, MI., free of charge. The hunt will be on Michigan Out of Doors before the end of this year.



Thanks to Legends Ranch for making these veterans feel so special and to giving them memories that will last a lifetime. Robert Sergi and his staff are truly the complete package.
