Nominations Being Accepted for our Chapter Board of Directors 2019

The Nominating Committee for the SCI- SE Michigan Bowhunters Chapter is accepting nominations for the upcoming elections for our chapter Board of Directors. The elections will take place at the June 2019 board meeting with ballots going out in early June.

To be considered as a candidate for the Board of Directors one must be a Chapter Member in good standing and shall have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years.

The Board of Directors consists of thirteen (13) Directors, elected from the membership for two-year terms, and two (2) Alternate Directors elected for one-year terms. This year there

will be seven Director positions open due to expiring terms, and two Alternate Director positions that are open each year.

As a result of the June elections, the top seven (7) vote-getters will fill the seven (7) open Director positions. The next two highest vote-getters will fill the 1st and 2nd Alternate Director positions, respectively. Each **Director and Alternate** Director elected at the June board meeting shall take office at the regularly scheduled Board meeting following the elections.

At that same meeting, a slate of Officer candidates from the new Board of Directors shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee. Nominations may also be made from the floor. Immediately thereafter, the Officers shall be elected for a term of one (1) year by the new Board of Directors.

This is a great opportunity for some of our members to get more involved with the club. The job is completely on a volunteer basis. It is rewarding. It is enlightening and educational. It encompasses a spirit of camaraderie. And, it is actually fun. If you are at all interested, please contact a member of the Nominating Committee listed below no later than May 15, 2019.
