

NOVI CHAPTER YOUTH HUNTER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

First Program Sat Sept. 28, 2019 10AM

It's hard to draw a large crowd the weekend before archery season starts but, the people who did attend were impressed with the information and tips that were presented to them. The program took place at Multi-Lakes Conservation Association. The Novi Chapter, Detroit Chapter and S.E. Michigan Bowhunters Chapters of SCI presented the program which was sponsored by our friends at Trijicon.

The first speaker was Chuck Bazzy of the Novi Chapter who also developed the program. Chuck covered almost every phase of using firearms for hunting. With Chuck's vast knowledge it was very difficult for him to contain his program to his two-hour limit. Courses that follow will have to be expanded to allow for all of the information that could be presented. The Q&A that followed his presentation also used up more time. The attendees were very impressed with Chucks knowledge of all firearms that spans over sixty years of hunting the world over. Chuck could have talked two hours on each subject he touched on. This maiden course was a good start to let Chuck know



how long he needs to extend his program.

The next speaker from the S.E. Michigan Bowhunters Chapter was Kevin Mulkeran who is a very accomplished bow hunter. Kevin understanding his time restraint decided to do a quick version of how to make sure your bow is tuned for shooting the broadheads needed to take game with a bow. Kevin invited the attendee's to be up close as he went over the tuning he goes thru when setting up his bow before each season. Naturally, each tuning segment brought questions that he answered as quickly as he could. Again, the students were very patient and appreciated his expertise while working under time limits. The bowhunting segment will also have to be expanded to properly cover the subjects.

All things considered, the Youth Hunter Development Program was a hit with the adults and youngsters who attended. There is just so much information to cover that it will have to be expanded to two separate courses in the future to cover the subjects properly. We can never get enough good info on hunting and these programs can't help but add to everyone's knowledge and understanding of what hunting is all about.
