FROLING FARMS BUFFALO HUNT

On our online Fundraiser auction in March, 2020 the very first item was a Buffalo hunt in Ionia, Michigan at Froling Farms. My good friend Jerry Petre had been looking for a place to get a Buffalo, as him and his wife like to eat Buffalo meat as often as they can. They were just about out of their supply of Buffalo and need more. I told him we had a Buffalo Hunt from Roger Froling and it would be #1 on our live auction list so, he should be sure to bid on it.

Just before our online Auction, Jerry's boiler and furnace broke, he called me and said now, he probably could not afford to bid on the Buffalo hunt. Knowing how much he and his wife wanted some Buffalo meat I told him I would split the cost and meat with him.



Jerry said if I did that, I could shoot the Buffalo (a-3 year old Bull) I replied, I would be glad to help him out. He won the bid and we contacted Roger to see when we could go up to his farm, Roger said he would contact us when he could line up a butcher.

June 1st, we headed up to Froling Farms in Ionia. It was the cleanest place I have ever seen. Roger had a friend of his with him that had been a guide in Alaska for 30 year and before that he was a Navy Seal. What a couple of great guys. I hadn't shot a Buffalo in 10 years. One shot, with my 45-70 and the Buffalo was ours. Roger had a butcher all lined up and even put the Buffalo in his trailer so, we could get it processed. We picked it up a week later, all vacuumed sealed and cut the way we wanted. COVID -TURKEY SEASON 2020

As we all suffer through these dark times related to Covid-19 it helps me and I hope others to reflect on the few activities that were possible or even better, were positively affected that is "HUNTING". As with many I was under furlough during the start of the hunting season. As luck would have it, I drew the first season and with time for some scouting before opening day I was ready to go on April 18, 2020. For those who remember this spring was very cold but, as I have said many times Turkey's just don't care when the spring starts calling. I have been hunting turkey exclusively with a bow for the last 6 years and as many who have tried it may take some additional time in the field to get the proper shot. However, when you get a tom to start buying what your selling (calls) and getting a shooter Tom within bow range makes it all worth it. I had had some incredible action with multiple birds this year and missed one on the first day but, when you aim for the head it happens. However, I can tell you if you miss it is clean miss and when you hit the target it is all done.



I was up every morning and visited two spots and on the third day had a Tom charge into my single hen decoy at 10 yards. Once he arrived, he slowly circled the hen and gave me a clean still shot which ended in game over. For the next month I was able to go out with friends meeting nearly every morning which resulted in 5 more birds during the season. It was time I normally would not have had and am very thankful for the opportunities offered and time spent with friends at the safe distance always available in the field. Thank you Covid for the extra days hunting!
