My good friend **Jerry Petre** had been looking for a place to get a Buffalo as, he and his wife like to eat it as often as they can and they were just about out. I told him we had a Buffalo Hunt donation from **Roger Froling** and it would be the #1 item on our live auction list. I told Jerry to be sure to bid on the Bison hunt if he wanted it.

Just before our online Auction, Jerry's boiler and furnace fell apart and he called me and said he probably could not afford to bid on Buffalo hunt now. Knowing how much he and his wife wanted some Buffalo meat I told him I would split the cost of the hunt with him. Jerry said if I did that that, I could shoot the Buffalo (a 3 year old Bull)

I told him I would do that for him. He won the bid and we contacted Roger to see when we could go up to his farm. Roger said he would contact us when he could line up a butcher. June 1st, we headed up to **Froling Buffalo Farm in Ionia in Michigan.**

It was the cleanest place I have ever seen! Roger had a friend of his **Bob Kerr**, with him that had been a guide in Alaska for 30 years, before that Bob was a Navy Seal. What a couple of great guys to spend the day with listening to hunting yarns!

I hadn't shot a Buffalo in over 10 years but, to do it again for Jerry was a pleasure. One shot tucked into the crease behind the front shoulder with my 7mm Mag and the Bison was ours. Roger had a butcher all lined up and even put it in his trailer so, we could

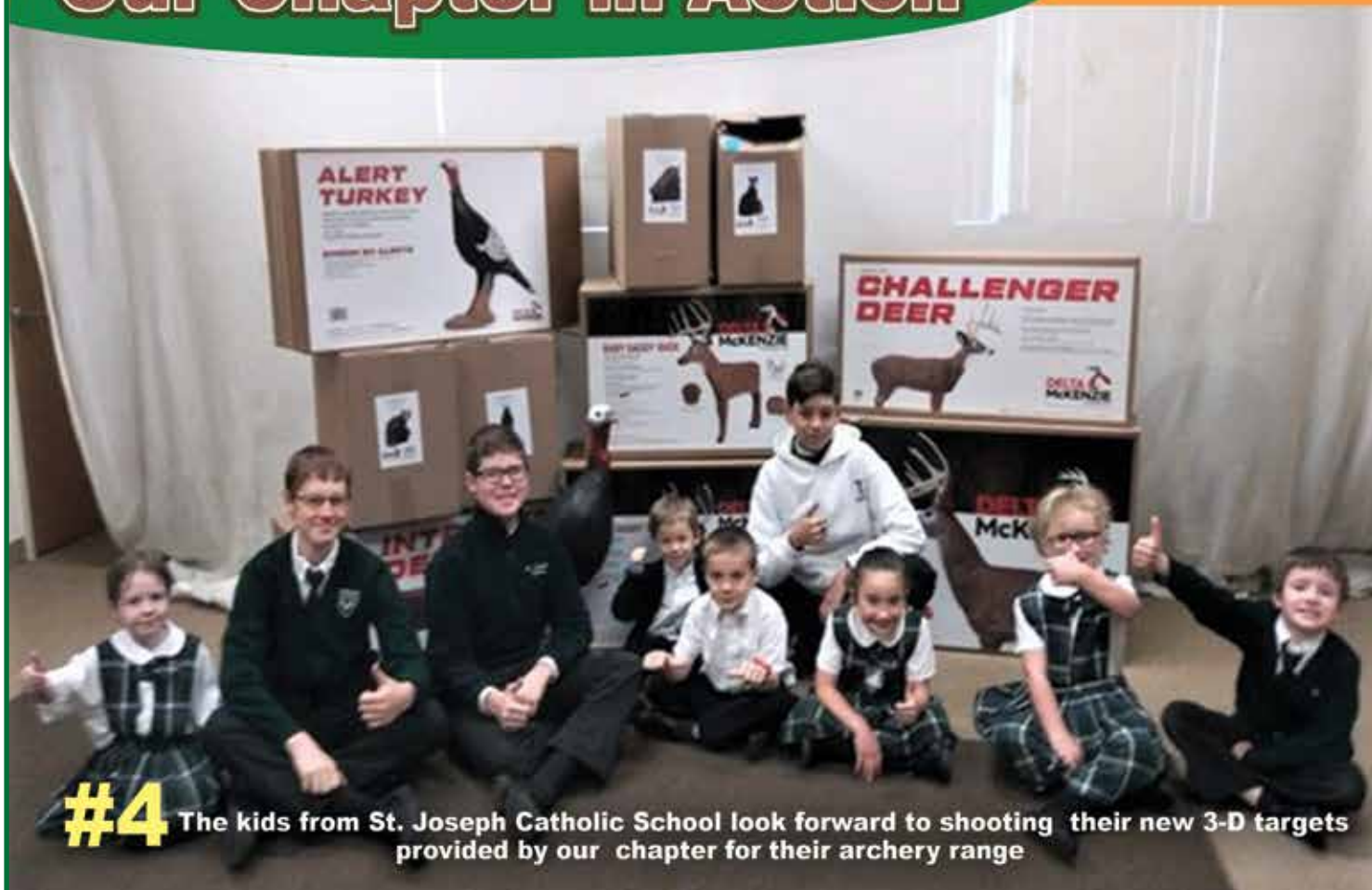

ROBOTIC DEER DECOYS DONATED TO OUR DNR

On Monday February 08, 2021, our SCI SE Michigan Bowhunters Chapter donated much needed Robotic Deer Decoys to Montmorency and Macomb counties DNR Law Divisions. The decoys are used to catch and prosecute poachers of our Michigan deer herd. The cost of these units is not in the DNR budget and have to be donated by sportsmen groups like ours.

Merle Shepard came to our board in January to ask our help to provide a lying down deer decoy for Montmorency DNR. Last March just before our fundraiser was cancelled, our chapter had approved donating a deer decoy to Brad Silorey of Macomb County DNR Law Division. We had to put that donation on hold till after our on-line live auction to see if we would have the funds to supply Macomb with their decoy.

This year our Board of Directors looked at our funds and after getting several bids we chose

who came in at \$1700 each, delivered. At that price, we could supply a deer decoy to each county.

An American Inspiration

This past November I got a call from a group of Veterans that were down at Camp Liberty (I have been their President for 7-years) they said there was a 98 Year Old World War 2 veteran down at camp that wanted to meet me. I told them I would be right down I didn't know what to expect when I arrived but, I was pleasantly surprised to meet Herb Elfring a gentleman I would guess to be about 75 years old not a 98 year old World War 2 Veteran. Here is his Story in his own words.

Herb vividly remembers the attack on Pearl Harbor on December-7, 1941 because he was there.

I was reading the bulletin board at the barracks when the first plane shot down at us the bullets were about 15 feet from me.

Elfring was about 3-miles from the harbor itself when it was bombarded by hundreds of Japanese fighter planes.

We went to our radar, which was in infancy at that time. It was used to detect planes at night to pass info to anti-aircraft guns.

Another plane came over and hit the radar signal -corps radio. As that plane came over it swerved off and a rain of bullets hit the radar. We were put on War status right away. The next day the United States Of America Declared War.

More than 2,000 Americans were killed in the attack with another 1,000 were injured. I've become more and more appreciative of being one of the remaining survivors out of 150 in 251st anti-aircraft artillery battery.

I may possibly be the last one alive out of 150. Its very emotional to be called "The greatest generation".

Elfring served his country from Sept.-16 1940

to Nov.-11 1945. He moved to Jackson after attending Michigan University on the G.I. bill. Herb and his late Wife Ruth had 5 children ranging from 58-72.

Since retiring from Consumers Energy in 1985 Herb has traveled to Egypt, England, New Zeland, Australia, Alaska and all over the United States, Being in the service you learn discipline and how to take care of yourself and how to work as a team.

It's disappointing in that after we did such a tremendous job of defeating the Germans and Japanese in World War 2 that we have so much conflict at this time.
