Wouldn't you know it, his dad had set up a family vacation trip for that date. Another call to Clarence and he said no problem, Matt could come up during the October bow season. Since Matt had not learned to shoot traditional bows or compound bows, we decided he could use my new Wicked Ridge 410 crossbow. After a few practice sessions he was ready to hunt if he kept his shots to 20-25 yards.

On Friday October 27 th, I picked Matt up after school and we were on our way to Clare. I provided him with one of my old ASAT camo outfits loaded with all the goodies I thought he might need. He had bought his mentor youth hunting license the day before and he was ready and excited to be on our way. It took us 3.5 long hours to get there.

When we arrived, Matt took a few practice shoots with the crossbow and Clarence led us the long way to the blind we would be hunting the next morning. We went to bed early and barely slept a wink, I was as excited as he was! The next morning, we were in our two-man ladder stand eighteen feet up a tree. We climbed into our stand a good half hour before first light and relaxed and took in the sounds of the woods coming to life. It was about 40 degrees, cool but not cold.

At 8am an eight-point buck showed himself from a trail to our right side of the stand just like Clarence said they would. We had a narrow tree about four feet in front of us to break up movements that might warn the deer. When I saw the buck, I thought Matt hadn't been hunting for an hour and he's already seeing a buck. It took me two years to see my first buck! Matt made a slight noise when he shifted to settle into his scope and SNORT! The buck was off and running. Darn, I felt so bad for Matt he was shaking like a leaf. I gave him a little pep talk, saying that we will see another deer and we settled back down to wait.

An hour later, another buck came in from the same trail that the other buck came from. I tapped Matt's leg and he saw the buck right away and was already looking through the scope. When the buck passed the tree in front of us Matt was ready to shoot. The buck stopped to investigate something, and at that moment the Wicked Ridge crossbow put the Muzzy tipped arrow right through the shoulders and down he went! Matt made a great shot, and he was shaking again but this time he had the biggest grin I have ever seen!

We both sat for a while to lake in the buck and the beautiful day. Matt called home to give his parents Jess and Mike the good news, telling them that pictures would follow soon. I called Clarence and soon he arrived with the other boys Kyle and Jack with the ATV and trailer to haul Matt's first buck back to the house. After tagging the buck and taking plenty of pictures the boys loaded the trailer and we headed towards the house where Clarence wanted the deer to be field dressed for the trip to the butcher. I got to drive the ATV back since I am according to them "the old guy"!

I already have a 15-year-old girl from my church lined up for this year's "Youth/Liberty Hunt" September 14-15. This hunting trip with Matt, Clarence, Kyle, and Jack made 2023 one of my best seasons ever. Hunting with the "Boys" even made me feel younger except for the "old man" talk. That hunting trip is why I will be a mentor until I can no longer take part! Let's hope that time is years from now!
