

Camp Grayling Disabled Veterans Deer Hunt 2025



NOVEMBER 7–9TH AT CAMP GRAYLING JOINT MANEUVER TRAINING CENTER

You must meet one of the following requirements to be eligible:

1. Veteran with an 80-100% disability rating or deemed individually unemployable by the USVA
2. Possess a permit from the Michigan DNR to hunt from a standing vehicle
3. Considered to be blind by MCL 393.351
4. Possess a permit from Michigan DNR to hunt using a laser sighting device.

A two-day archery/crossbow hunt (Nov. 8 and 9) for white-tailed deer will be held at Camp Grayling for individuals with disabilities.

Hunters must apply for this hunt by filling out the application below and emailing to jdavis@nwtf.net along with proof of eligibility (copy of letter from USVA showing 80-100% disability or individually unemployable, photocopy of MDNR permit to hunt from a standing vehicle *or* laser-sighting device, paperwork from the State of Michigan proving legally blind status).

Applications will be drawn on October 7th. The 10 applicants drawn will be invited to participate. If any of those 10 hunters cannot accept the invitation, additional names will be drawn and invited to participate. Applicants who have not participated in previous years will receive priority.
